How do I read the table?

Listed below, you can find the application deadlines and study abroad periods within each degree programme (see example).

Highlighted in grey = recommended period abroad

Which countries do the regions contain?

Europe = Erasmus / all European countries incl. UK and Turkey, except Russia Overseas = North America, Latin and South America, Asia, Russia, Israel, Marocco, South Africa, Australia and New Zealand

Example: 15 October in the third study semester is the application deadline for a study abroad period in Overseas in the 5th or 6th semester.
