Applications for the Online Exchange Initiative

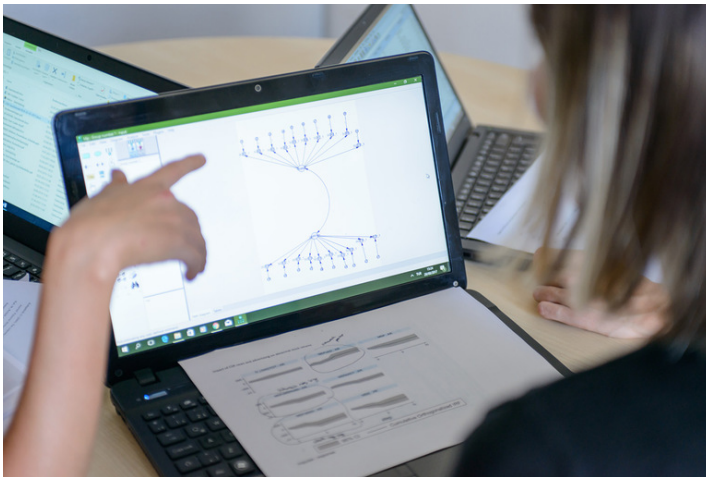
