Processed Data Categories

We are only processing data that is visibly collected during the registration process. We will take photos during the event.

Purpose of Data Processing

Carrying out and confirming the registration; holding the event (planning and organizing)

Legal Basis

- For carrying out and confirming the registration as well as holding the event: art. 6 subsection 1 letter e in conjunction with art. 6 subsection 3 of the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) in conjunction with section 4 of the Data Protection Act of the Land of Baden-Württemberg (LDSG BW).
- For making a list of persons taking part at the event: art. 6 subsection 1 letter a GDPR.
- For photos depicting the nature of the event (overview photos): art. 6 subsection 1 letter e in conjunction with art. 6 subsection 3 GDPR in conjunction with section 4 LDSG BW.
- Other photos can only be taken upon authorization (see art. 6 subsection 1 letter a GDPR).

Duration of Storage

- As a rule, data is deleted when the follow-up work of the event is completed (usually one to two months after the event).
- Photos are deleted ten years after the event at the latest. In case a photo was subject to authorization and the authorization was given, the photo will be deleted immediately after the authorization is withdrawn.

Your Rights

- You have the right to obtain information about your data stored by the University of Mannheim and the right to have false data rectified.
- Furthermore, you have the right to erasure, the right to restriction of processing and the right to object processing.
- In case you authorized during the registration that individual photos may be taken of you and your name may be published on the list of persons supervising a table, you have the right to withdraw the authorization at any time. The withdrawal does not affect the lawfulness of processing based on your authorization before its withdrawal.
- You have the right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority if you are of the opinion that the processing of your personal data is not in compliance with data protection regulations.

The supervisory authority responsible is the commissioner for data protection and freedom of information of Baden-Württemberg (Landesbeauftragter für den Datenschutz und die Informationsfreiheit Baden-Württemberg).

II. Information on Your Right to Object According to Art. 21 Subsection 1 GDPR

On grounds relating to your particular situation, you have the right to object to the processing of your personal data according to art. 6 subsection 1 letter e GDPR (data processing in the public interest) at any time.
