The online exchange is a joint initiative of *University of Mannheim, LUISS University, NHH Norwegian School of Economics, Tilburg University, University of National and World Economy, University of Toulouse 1 Capitole, and WU Vienna University of Economics and Business*. Students have the possibility to apply for online courses offered at other partner institutions subject to the details and conditions listed below. Please note that the conditions for application and admission differ from one institution to another depending on the local regulations.

Application process	<p>Interested students can apply by sending an e-mail to erasmus.incoming@unwe.bg (Subject: "Application to Online Exchange Initiative").</p> <p>Application requirements: enrollment in a bachelor's program at a partner university; minimum of one year of full-time studies completed (60 ECTS-Credits).</p> <p>Application documents:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Confirmation of enrollment home university ➤ Transcript of records ➤ Statement of purpose, incl. courses you would like to attend <p>In the application students can indicate a maximum of 3 course preferences and the title of courses they would like to attend.</p> <p>The selection will be based on an evaluation of the applicant's overall academic performance (transcript of records) and the statement of purpose. UNWE will notify its partner universities about the selected students. Partner universities have to confirm their students admission to UNWE's courses.</p>
Application period	<p>The application period runs from August 1 to August 31, 2020.</p> <p>All applicants will be informed about the outcome of their application at the latest by September 10, 2020.</p>
Fees and other administrative aspects	<p>No administrative and/or tuition fees will be charged.</p> <p>Costs for expenditures like reading materials, literature would have to be borne by the students (if applicable).</p>
