





Enrollment

- ✓ Valid visa
- ✓ All fees paid
- ✓ German address entered in Portal2 (please enter this yourself)
- ✓ M10 (health insurances information) in Portal2

The following documents must be submitted:

• Portal2 (electronic transmission): Proof of health insurance coverage with a statutory health insurance provider or exemption from compulsory insurance, transmitted to electronically

•Application Portal: Visa or residence permit (if required), via upload in the Application Portal



Opening a German bank account

- Many banks charge no fees for student bank accounts e.g. Deutsche Bank, Postbank
- Some banks also have free accounts for everyone
 → you will not be charged when you graduate
- You will be able to open a German bank account after you have ...



- ... registered your address and ...
- ... acquired your **Tax ID number** (Steueridentifikationsnummer) from the local Tax Authority (Finanzamt)
- \rightarrow You can usually get this from the desk at the Tax Authority three days after you have registered your address.






