## - Open call for new courses

### SULaw Summer Programme

Our Summer Programme at Department of Law, Stockholm University has been in place since 2017, and the number of participating students has increased each year. We are now looking for lecturers/professors who would want to teach a course during our summer programme 2023.

The programme runs for three sessions of two weeks each, a total of six weeks during the summer. All our courses are worth 3,5 ECTS. You can choose to teach in any of the sessions listed below.

Session 1 = 26 June – 7 July  
Session 2 = 10 July – 21 July  
Session 3 = 24 July – 4 August

SULaw are open as to the subjects but the course preferably has a comparative and/or international focus. The teaching is in English, and will be aimed towards international undergraduate students coming from SULaw partner universities from all over the world.

### Administrative requirements

You would need to create the course syllabus and detailed course description. More information will be sent to the selected course(s) in December. The courses are planned on-campus at Stockholm University with 12 teaching hours/two week session and 3h of examination (15 h total). The examination format should preferably be a take-home assignment or another type of examination such as an open book exam/mock exercise.

### Practical aspects

The mobility will be financed via the Erasmus+ programme as a combined mobility for teaching and professional development. This will cover accommodation, travels etc. The selected teachers must coordinate the application for funding with their home university. Once the funding is secured we can help with securing accommodation. After completion of the course, a certificate of teaching excellence will be issued.

If you are interested in teaching in our summer programme 2023, please send us a course proposal via the email address below. We would need your proposal at the latest by **Sunday 20 November**. Please make sure to state your preferred session for teaching.
