Ranging from jointly offered Summer Schools, Signature Courses, and Joint Study Programmes including micro-credentials.
- **ENGAGE.EU Think Tank** establishes formats of advanced studies to underpin the activities of the alliance in education, research and innovation and societal outreach by bringing research communities together to address societal challenges in order to strengthen evidence-based decision making within the alliance and beyond.
- **ENGAGE.EU Labs** are innovative models of collaboration and co-creation on societal change challenges, consisting of mixed groups of learners, academics and practitioners.
- **ENGAGE.EU Dual Learning** brings practitioners into the learning, research and innovation arena, promoting local and international responsibility. It allows multiple directions of learning by focusing on the interaction between practitioners, science, and all ENGAGE.EU learners.
