Promotion of young researchers in the field of empirical models on social processes by the *Prof. Dr. Anna und Prof. Dr. Jörg Jiri Bojanovsky-Stiftung*

Dear Colleagues,

I am pleased to announce that, once again, the *Prof. Dr. Anna und Prof. Dr. Jörg Jiri Bojanovsky-Stiftung* plans to honor excellent research work by young researchers of the University of Mannheim with the *Bojanovsky Prize* in 2024.

According to the purpose of the foundation, the prize shall be awarded to researchers in the field of "empirical models on social processes". This includes empirical research or modeling of social, inter-individual and cultural processes.

The *Bojanovsky foundation* considers articles in peer reviewed journals as well as published monographs that may or may not be based on a PhD thesis. Papers and monographs published in 2023 or 2024 as well as manuscripts accepted for publication can be submitted as long as they are published not later than six years after the PhD defense. The prize money for journal articles and monographs is 1,000 euros each.

The following documents need to be attached to the applications for the *Bojanovsky Prize*:

- one copy of the journal article or the monograph,
- in case of dissertation-based publications, the evaluations of the dissertation thesis,
- short version of the author's CV with a list of publications,
- for articles and monographs not yet published, an acceptance form from the editor or publisher,
- in case of co-authorships, a declaration of the applicant's share in the entire work, signed by all co-authors.

The application deadline is **26 April 2024**. Applications have to be forwarded to the President's Office via Division IV - Finance and Procurement (attn: Ms. Schulz-Kaltenbach).
