STATUS GROUPS DURING THE DOCTORATE

For all status groups – doctoral students, staff members, dual-role doctoral students, doctoral candidates – equally applies:

University Library

The rights of use in the University Library are independent of your status: everybody who is officially accepted as a doctoral candidate receives the same rights in the library system as employees, e.g. the possibility of semester borrowing from the library areas, ordering articles and book sections, or a higher fee limit. Whether you are enrolled and/or employed at the university is therefore irrelevant for the use of the University Library.

Bulletin of the President's Office
