Week	Tasks and deadlines
1 11.02.–17.02.	Registration and topic assignments <i>Register via Portal2 until Feb 11. Explore the list of topics and select at least 3 topics of your preference. You may also propose alternative topics relevant to the seminar. If you are accepted into the seminar, provide your preferred topics by Feb 17 via email to Kiril Gashteovski (k.gashteovski@uni-mannheim.de). The actual topic assignment takes place soon afterwards; we will notify you via email. As soon as you receive your topic, start studying the relevant literature. You will also serve as a reviewer for the seminar report of another student and as a moderator for the presentation of yet another student (see below for details). Likewise, you will be assigned a <i>reviewer</i> and <i>moderator</i> (both students) for your presentation and report, resp., as well as a university <i>tutor</i>.</i>
2 18.02.–24.02.	Kick-off meeting & contact tutor <i>The kick-off meeting will be held on Feb 20 (tentative). Attendance is mandatory. Schedule an appointment with your tutor.</i>
3-6 25.02.–24.03.	Explore literature <i>Study the relevant literature for your topic.</i>
6-7 18.03.–31.03.	Tutor meeting <i>Meet with your assigned <i>tutor</i> to discuss your paper: bring outline and give a brief oral summary of your paper (about 10 minutes). Ask questions but do not bring your report yet.</i>
7 25.03.–31.03	Flash presentation <i>Give a 3-minute flash presentation Mar 27 (tentative). Attendance to all talks is required.</i>
8-10 01.04.–05.05.	Report submission (1st version) <i>Send your report to your <i>reviewer</i> and to your <i>tutor</i> by May 05.</i>

11 06.05.–12.05.	Report review submission / Tutor meeting <i>Read the report of your fellow student without consulting the original paper. Fill out the peer review form provided to you.
