## Schedule and Deadlines

Week	Tasks and deadlines
1 14.02–20.02	Register via Portal2 until Feb 14. Explore the list of topics and select at least 4 topics of your preference. You may also propose alternative topics relevant to the seminar. If you are accepted to the seminar, provide your preferred topics by Feb 20 via e-mail to Daniel Ruffinelli. The actual topic assignment takes place soon afterwards; we will notify you via email. As soon as you receive your topic, find 2 or 3 focus papers for your topic and once they are approved by the tutor, start studying them. You will also serve as a reviewer for the seminar report of another student. You will be assigned a university tutor.
<b>2</b> 21.02–27.02	Kick-off meeting & contact tutor  The kick-off meeting will be held on Feb 23 (tentative). Attendance is mandatory! Schedule an appointment with your tutor.
<b>3-6</b> 28.02–27.03	Explore literature, select focus papers  Explore the literature and select 2 or 3 papers that you want to focus on in this seminar. Send the list of papers to your tutor by Mar 06, explaining why you selected those as your focus papers. Once the papers have been approved by your tutor, start stydying them in depth.
<b>6</b> 21.03–27.03	Tutor meeting  Meet with your assigned tutor to discuss your papers: bring an outline and give a brief oral summary of each paper (about 15 minutes in total). Ask questions but do not bring your report yet.
<b>7</b> 28.03–03.04	Flash Presentation Give a 3-minute flash presentation about your topic on Mar 30 (tentative). Attendance to all talks is required.

<b>8-10</b> 04.04–08.05	Report submission (1 <sup>st</sup> version) Submit your report via ILIAS by $May 08$ .
11 09.05–15.05	Peer review submission  Read the report of your fellow student without consulting the original papers. Fill out the peer review form provided to you. The peer review is done anonymously (no one is aware who their reviewer is). Submit your feedback via ILIAS until May 15.
