Week	Tasks and deadlines
1 05.09–11.09	Registration and topic assignments <i>Register via Portal2 until Sep 5th. Explore the list of topics and select at least 4 topics of your preference. You may also propose alternative topics relevant to the seminar. If you are accepted to the seminar, provide your preferred topics by Sep 11th via e-mail to Daniel Ruffinelli. The actual topic assignment takes place soon afterwards; we will notify you via email. As soon as you receive your topic, start working on it. You will also serve as a reviewer for the seminar report of another student. You will be assigned a university tutor.</i>
2 12.09–18.09	Kick-off meeting & contact tutor <i>The kick-off meeting will be held on Sep 14th (tentative). Attendance is mandatory! Schedule an appointment with your tutor.</i>
3-6 19.09–16.10	Study your topic, explore further literature <i>Study your assigned topic and explore the literature.</i>
6 10.10–16.10	Tutor meeting <i>Meet with your assigned tutor to discuss your topic: bring an outline and give a brief oral summary of the topic (about 15 minutes in total). Ask questions but do not bring your report yet.</i>
7 17.10–23.10	Flash Presentation <i>Give a 3-minute flash presentation on Oct 19th (tentative). Attendance to all talks is required.</i>
8-10 24.10–13.11	Report submission (1st version) <i>Submit your report via ILIAS by Nov 13th.</i>
11 14.11–20.11	Peer review submission <i>Read the report of your fellow student without consulting the original material. Fill out the peer review form provided to you. The peer review is done anonymously (no one is aware who their reviewer is). Submit your feedback via ILIAS until Nov 20th.</i>
12 23.11–27.11	Tutor meeting <i>Schedule a meeting with your tutor for the week. Bring a draft of your final presentation.</i>
13 28.11–04.12	Presentation <i>Give a presentation (15+5) on Nov 30th/Dec 1st (tentative). Attendance to all talks is required.</i>
