1 04.09–10.09.	Registration and topic assignments Register via Portal2 until Sep 4. If you are accepted into the seminar, provide at least 4 topic areas
	of your preference (your own and/or from seminar's website, which see) by Sep 10 via email to Adrian Kochsiek. The actual topic area assignment takes place soon afterwards; we will notify you via email. As soon as you receive your topic area, start studying the relevant literature. You will be assigned a university tutor as a primary contact point during the seminar.
2 11.09.–17.09.	Kick-off meeting The kick-off meeting will be held on Sep 13th, 17:15 (tentative).
3-5 18.09.–08.10.	Explore literature Study the relevant literature for your topic area. Propose a self-selected topic and a corresponding (starting) research paper to your tutor by Sep 27 at the latest; we will let you know whether this topic is suitable.
6 09.10.–15.10.	Tutor meeting Meet with your assigned tutor (meetings scheduled by us via Doodle). Present a brief oral overview of your topic area and your self-selected topic (5-10 minutes). Bring at least an outline, ideally a complete draft of your flash presentation. Ask questions but do not bring your report yet.
7 16.10.–22.10.	Flash Presentation Give a 3-minute flash presentation on Oct 18 (tentative). Attendance to all presentations is required.
8-9 23.10.–05.11.	Report submission (1 st version) Submit your report via ILIAS by Nov 5. This version is not graded.
10 06.11.–12.11.	Peer review submission Read the report of your fellow student without consulting the original papers. Fill out the peer review form provided to you. The peer review is done anonymously (no one is aware who their reviewer is). Submit your feedback via ILIAS until Nov 12.
