3 21.09 – 27.09	Topic assignment <i>Topics are assigned on 22 Sep; we will notify you by e-mail. You will also serve as reviewer for the seminar reports of two fellow students.</i>
4 28.09 – 04.10	Literature exploration <i>As soon as you have been assigned your topic area and seed paper, start studying the relevant literature and understand the fundamentals of your topic.</i>
5 05.10 – 11.10	Optional tutor meeting <i>Optionally meet your tutor this week to discuss your topic (schedule appointment via e-mail). Bring an outline and give a brief oral overview of your topic and paper (5-10 minutes).</i>

9 02.11 – 08.11	Peer reviews <i>Read the two draft reports assigned to you without consulting the original papers and prepare your review. The peer review is anonymous (i.e., no one knows who the reviewer is).</i>
10 09.11 – 15.11	Peer review submission <i>Submit your reviews by 15 Nov via ILIAS. You will then receive the reviews of your own draft shortly afterwards.</i>
11 16.11 – 22.11	Revision & presentation preparation <i>Incorporate the peer review to further update your report. Prepare your final presentation.</i>
12 – 14 23.11 – 13.12	Final presentations (tentative) <i>Submit your slides by 24 Nov / 01 Dec / 08 Dec via ILIAS. Give a presentation on 25 Nov / 02 Dec / 09 Dec. All students are expected to attend all presentations.</i>
