Abstract:

There has been an evolving awareness across psychological sciences that the very way we produce, communicate, and verify knowledge needs improvement. In this workshop I focus on the pragmatics of conducting transparent and reliable open science. Often people do not want to invest additional time, and so I teach this workstation with the theme that adopting transparent methods should save you time, money, and frustration. I show how adopting “high reliability principles” from organizational psychology leads to productive lab practices.
