### Research Grants for Academics directly affected by the War in Ukraine

from funds of the Ukraine Emergency Fund of the  
University of Mannheim Foundation

In order to support researchers who are at risk due to the war in Ukraine, the University of Mannheim Foundation grants research scholarships with a duration of up to 12 months of the emergency fund set up for this purpose. The scholarship holders are accepted as guest researchers at a chair/institute of the university that matches their research profile and receive support in arriving in Germany and in working on their research projects.

<b>Target Group</b>	PhD students and postdocs directly affected by the war in Ukraine from all disciplines represented at the University of Mannheim
<b>Förderung candidate</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Basic scholarship amounting up to 1,250 EUR per month for doctoral Basic scholarship in the amount of up to 1,750 EUR per month for doctoral students</li><li>2. One-off travel allowance of up to 500 EUR.</li><li>3. Monthly child allowance of 400 EUR for the first child, 100 EUR for each additional child.</li></ol>
<b>Funding phase</b>	12 months max.
<b>Deadline</b>	Applications may be submitted at any time as long as sufficient scholarship funds are available.
<b>Eligibility Requirements</b>	Candidates must meet the following requirements: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>– Master's degree or doctorate</li><li>– comprehensible risk situation (to be submitted as a self- declaration)</li><li>– sufficient German or English language skills</li><li>– Commitment of an academic host at chair/institute at the University of Mannheim</li></ul>

**The following documents in German or English must be submitted for the application:**

- academic curriculum vitae
- Certificate of the Master's degree or doctorate
- Personal statement on the personal risk situation (max. 1 page)
- Brief description of own research project (max. 2 pages)
- Letter of support from the academic host department including the confirmation of academic supervision (max. 2 pages)
