MULTITUDE concentrates on the Arabic- or Kurdish-speaking minority-migrants from Turkey in Germany. To analyse how one generation's linguistic experiences affect the next generation's linguistic future, in-depth interviews have been conducted. Within the project, a survey will be conducted as well.
